#### THANKS FROM THE CCCC

For the last seven years, the Chiltern Child Contact Centre has been one of the charities St Aidan's helps to support, via fundraising efforts such as the May Fayre and Grand Draw. The treasurer has written to us on behalf of the charity to express their thanks: "You have sent us a grand total over 7 years of £12,500. This represents a truly remarkable level of support. In fact, it covers one year's expenses and we are truly grateful to everyone at St Aidan's who made this possible."

For those who wish to know more about this charity, the following is taken from the Coordinator's report to their AGM in July 2018: "The Centre had helped 24 families during the year with 33 children attending. This compared with 13 families and 17 children during the previous year. There is a policy of actively helping separated families to 'move on' making their own arrangements for the non-resident parent and children to meet. During the year 10 families had successfully completed this process. The Coordinator of the Centre is just about to retire after 3 very successful years, which has seen the Centre develop into well managed undertaking, supported by volunteers and trustees. Her replacement is due to start in early 2019."

A wonderful resource aimed at younger children 'YOUCAT for Kids' is now available. This is a great tool for catechists, and for parents and carers as they pass on their faith to children.
