Ash Wednesday: On February 14, we begin the season of Lent, with Ash Wednesday, (annoyingly coincides with Valentines Day!). Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are to be observed as days of Fast and Abstinence. Fasting means that the amount of food we eat is considerably reduced. Abstinence means that we give up meat and other particular kinds of food or drink or forms of amusement. Those over eighteen are bound by the law of fasting until the beginning of their sixtieth year, while all over fourteen are bound by the law of abstinence. There will be Mass in both Churches, ashes will be blessed and imposed on your forehead during Mass.


