Thank you for the Parish Lunch at St. Aidan's: Our sincere appreciation and heartfelt thanks to Deirdre, Mary Crawshaw and Sue for providing delicious lunch to many of our parishioners last Sunday. There was plenty of food and conversation. God bless you all.

First Holy Communion at Our Lady's: The First batch of children will receive the communion on this **Sunday (15th May), 9.30am**, followed by refreshments in the parish hall. The second batch will have the Mass on Sunday 22nd May. The candidates and their families are allocated the front pews.

Support our Local Food Bank: The volunteers at Chiltern Foodbank send this message, "Thank you for all you are doing to collect food for us to give to our clients. The food that your church gives makes a big difference to the people who receive it. We are seeing the need for food parcels starting to increase across our area, including Chesham and Amersham. For example, a couple of people we have recently given food parcels to are: Someone who was homeless and has just been given a bedsit to live in, but who had no food or kitchen things etc. Someone else who works a few hours a week in a low paid job and is always keen to get more hours of work, but the employer only calls her in when they are particularly busy, so her income varies week by week and often isn't enough. Like most of our clients, they were both very grateful for the food we gave them. You asked about things that we particularly need at the moment: **cooking oil, ketchup, sponge puddings, angel delight.**"

No Children's Liturgy: Please note there will be no children's liturgy on this **Sunday 15th May** and **Sunday 22nd May** at Our Lady's, as we have First Communion Mass on those dates.

33 Day Consecration to Jesus through Mary: A few copies of the above-mentioned book are available for free read. They are kept in the porch at our lady's. Please feel free to use them.

White Hill Centre: is looking for up to ten local families to host Italian Junior & High School pupils for two weeks in July. These pupils attend catholic schools in Rome and southern Italy and stay in groups of two. Each group of 2 boys or girls stay as paying guests in a local host family. They expect breakfast, a packed lunch to go and an evening meal, plus light laundry. All pupils are out almost daily, from 8.30am to around 9pm. **The daily contribution per pupil is £30: thus £210 per week per pupil, or £840 for the entire fortnight in double occupancy.** Note that many of the pupils become genuinely friendly with host families and often return every summer, even for 3 or 4 programs.
