Ash Wednesday: This Wednesday, **22**nd **February**, we celebrate Ash Wednesday and begin our forty days of Lenten journey. Lent asks us to set aside a time of fasting, prayer, and almsgiving. 
Food Bank: Please continue with our donations as previously, namely: tinned meat, tinned tuna, sponge puddings. rice puddings, custard and UHT milk.
