

**Chiltern Foodbank:** For Easter food parcels: small Easter Eggs, adult chocolates, tinned ravioli and packets of macaroni cheese. These would be gratefully received by our local families.

**Tap N Go Milestone:** Since the Tap N Go machine was installed at Our Lady's in May 2023, generous parishioners have donated more than *£20,000* through the machine for Parish Offertory, Easter and Christmas Offerings, second collections and donations. 77% of this amount has been gift aided which has meant that an additional £3,000 has been claimed for the parish. It only takes a few minutes to set up your offerings for gift aid, and then any further offerings will automatically be gift aided. The Tap N Go Machine itself was paid for from a generous donation from a parishioner, that too was gift aided. Thank you for supporting the work of the church and our parish community.

**Prison Chaplaincy Opportunity:** Have you ever thought how you could play a crucial role in the rehabilitation of prisoners, to look for the good in someone and encourage its nurture and growth? *HMP Grendon & Springhill* are looking to contract a chaplain for 20 hours per week.
