World Mission Sunday: This Sunday, (22nd October), the Mass is celebrated exclusively for missionary activity. Donations are collected at these worldwide Masses, and they go, in their entirety, to support churches, hospitals, schools and vocations in countries where the Church is new, young or poor. World Mission Sunday is our chance to show love and solidarity to our brothers and sisters overseas who share our faith. **Missio** is responsible for coordinating World Mission Sunday and provides new, young or poor dioceses with the essential support they need on their journey to becoming self-sufficient. **There will be a Second Collection this weekend to support the work of Missio.**

All Saints Day: On **Wednesday 1st November**, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of All Saints. It's a **Holy Day of Obligation** for us. There will be Masses in both Churches on the day. **Our Lady's: 9.30am, St. Aidan's: 7.00pm.**

All Souls Day: On Thursday 2nd November, we remember the Holy Souls and offer special Masses for them. We shall have Mass in both Churches. Our Lady's: 9.30am, St. Aidan's: 7.00pm. We shall also have the **Blessing of the Graves** on the day. **Stanley Hill Cemetery: 11.am, St. Aidan's burial ground after the evening Mass.** May I request the families to be present and help me to identify the graves. We will begin with special prayers and then bless the individual graves. **Holy Souls Envelopes are available at the back of the Church.**
