3.2	Update from Clergy Meeting											
	<p>Fr Sean reported on the meeting of the clergy held on 4<sup>th</sup> November at St Teresa's.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Clergy appointments</b> - our new priests had been welcomed to our pastoral area.</li> <li><b>Priscilla Oriabure, Chaplain of St Michael's School</b>, had outlined her role for students and staff. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>She has devised a road map for students by which to live their faith in a positive way. This had been well received by staff.</li> <li>This is the only Catholic school in the area where pupils can go through school from nursery to 6<sup>th</sup> form. Only 32% of children are nominally Catholic which is a challenge for her. There are 1000 youngsters of many faiths or none. She's trying to enliven the atmosphere.</li> <li>She has a genuine concern for ensuring that pupils not only practise their faith but that they live their faith through outreach and lived experiences.</li> <li>The school is very grateful for the support it receives for their sacramental programmes. Priests go into the school in Advent and Lent to help with the sacrament of Reconciliation.</li> <li>The school staff hold a weekly prayer session which she coordinates. She asked if our Priests/Deacons might be willing to join them on occasions to lead the prayer for them and encourage the staff. Fr Sean will try to draw up a rota for people who would be willing to help with this.</li> </ul> </li> </ol>	Fr Sean										

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• She will consider how the pastoral area might provide further support.</li> </ul> <p>iii. <b>Annual Priests Conference 2026</b> - this will be held in June at Highgate House in Creton. The priests of each pastoral area had been asked to submit two topics for consideration for the 2026 agenda. One of our topics was "<b>The Future of our Catholic Schools</b>" which was accepted enthusiastically. Another topic to consider might be "<b>The success of our immigrant communities in leading Catechesis – how can we learn from them?</b>".</p> <p>iv. <b>Advent and Christmas</b> – Dates for services of Reconciliation had been agreed.</p> <p>v. <b>Emmaus Programme</b> – Fr Sean had reminded parishes to make a further £100 donation per parish to support the programme going forward. Fr Roy brought donations from his two parishes.</p> <p>vi. <b>Clergy Christmas Party</b> will be held at St Teresa's on <b>Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> December</b></p>	
	<b>3.2</b>	<b>Update from Chairs and Deans Meeting</b>	
		<p>Joan reported on the meeting held via Zoom in October which had been led by Avril Baigent and Fr Francis Higgins.</p> <p>i. <b>Two new Deans</b> had been appointed: Fr Tony Brennan for Slough and Fr Jaismon Francis for Aylesbury.</p> <p>ii. <b>Assembly 2026</b> plans are in abeyance pending discussions with Bishop David.</p> <p>iii. <b>Discernment Process</b> - Aylesbury had completed this and their review was due at end of October 2025. They had consulted widely and engaged 400 people in the process. One positive development was to centralise the youth activities of two parishes within the parish that had facilities to support them. Parishioners in the more affluent parish were supporting the less affluent parish. Luton and North Northants are going through Discernment Process at this time. South Bucks Pastoral Area – We should start to consider in 2026 how we might prepare ourselves ahead of this discernment process in our own area.</p> <p>iv. <b>Diocesan Assembly</b> if this goes ahead there would be preparatory work involved.</p> <p>v. 5.	<p><b>Emmaus Programme 2026</b></p> <p><b>Finance</b> - to date we have received contributions from Immaculate Heart of Mary, St Peter's and St Columba's with St Teresa's making a £200 contribution this week. Initial parish contributions and donations received had sustained the programme for two years. Fr Jerome said that not everyone has taken a stipend for their talk.</p> <p>The programme for 2026 is almost complete. Deacon Peter has kindly offered to give a talk in June as Deacon Sean Ryan is not available. He will advise Fr Jerome and Christine of his topic. Fr Jerome will chase Fr Simon for his topic for November.</p>	Dcn Peter Fr Jerome
6.	<p><b>CATECHISTS AGM</b></p> <p>Christine had spoken to Alex Heath. The current proposal is to possibly move the date of the AGM from February into the summer months. The meeting was scheduled to be held in the Centre at the Cathedral but there is now another meeting in there so the Catechists AGM is currently scheduled to meet in Bishop's House. This would mean that a much smaller group of people could attend if held in February.</p> <p>If, in the meantime, any parish has any issues or requires catechetical support please contact Alex Heath direct.</p> <p><b>Jubilee of Catechists</b> - As it had not been possible to hold an event at the time of this Jubilee in October, the postponement of the Catechists AGM now gives us an opportunity to hold an event for our Paastoral Area Catechists in Lent 2026. IHM would be happy to host this. Deacon Peter would propose a date and contact Georgia Clarke at the parish of St Elizabeth of Portugal, Richmond to see if she could speak to us about their approach to sacramental preparation. If she is not available, we should still bring our catechists and liturgists together to maintain the momentum from our 2024 event. Our School Chaplains would also be invited. We should also extend invitations to Martin Fahey and John Traynor who has previously had responsibility for RE in schools and Sophie Davies, RE Coordinator, St Joseph's School.</p> <p>There needs to be an opportunity for us to share resources and experiences during the day.</p> <p>Applications for the Youth Worker in the Four Parishes close on 28<sup>th</sup> November. 7.	<p><b>SAFEGUARDING</b></p> <p>Last week was National Safeguarding Sunday in the UK. In the Catholic Church we have an International Day for Safeguarding which had been celebrated earlier in the year.</p> <p>Deacon Peter is working with the Healing and Reconciliation Team to develop an Accompaniment Team to accompany people who have been abused or suffer from addictions. He hopes to be able to share more on this in the New Year.</p> <p>The current chair had agreed to stay in post as Head of Safeguarding Board until his successor has been appointed.</p> <p><b>Catholics in Recovery</b> – A parishioner had come to Fr Sean about this programme re: abuse or addiction. She was particularly concerned about domestic abuse. Fr Sean and Deacon</p>	Dcn Peter  Mgr Sean

	Peter will meet with Philippa and then, pending the outcome of the conversation, see if she might give a presentation on this to our PAC in February. It was noted that the Pope's intention this month is to support those who are depressed and have suicidal thoughts. Hopefully we could offer support in the form of a pastoral area group rather than by individual parishes. Maria is aware of people in SVP who have problems with addictions – how do we walk alongside them? We need to look outward to recognise the signs of abuse or addiction.	
<b>7.</b>	<b>OUTSTANDING ACTIONS</b>	
	i. <b>Parish Pastoral Councils</b> – Next year we may look at what we have as parish pastoral councils across our pastoral area. Avril's accompaniment sessions are currently running on Re-imagining Pastoral Councils. ii. <b>St Carlos Acutis</b> – St Peter's are still waiting to receive their relic of St Carlos Acutis. They are still planning to hold the Carlo Acutis Festival in 2026. iii. <b>40 Hour Adoration</b> – We need a successor to Fr Jithu to take the lead on organising 40 hrs Adoration in our Pastoral Area. This will be discussed at our February meeting. <b>8.1</b>	i. <b>Mission Northampton.</b> The Council of Priests had had a talk from Maria Heath on Evangelisation, forming Missionary Disciples and Multiplication. A House of Mission and Prayer had recently opened in Northampton. Maria would be happy to give a talk to the PAC on the role of Mission Northampton. It was felt that this was not necessary at this time as she had already covered this during her Emmaus talk on "Missonary Discipleship this year." ii. <b>Mission Conference 2026</b> will be held at Woburn Sandon 14 <sup>th</sup> March 2026. iii. <b>Bethsaida Course</b> - Applications are still being accepted for the Bethsaida course. Formation for leadership skills and practical ideas locally. iv. <b>Alpha Course</b> - Deacon Peter reported that their cluster of four parishes is hoping to run an Alpha Course. This would be led by Catholic Facilitators but open to all. Maybe Mission Northampton could customise a course for us. There is an Alpha Training Day on 7 <sup>th</sup> February in Luton. The aim is to run Alpha between Easter and Pentecost 2026 at Damien Hall in Great Missenden. Deacon Peter will engage with other parishes in the area over the winter months. Everyone to consider "who could they bring along". v. <b>Advent Retreat</b> - The online Diocesan Advent Retreat run by the Pastoral Development Department starts on Monday 24 <sup>th</sup> November. vi. <b>St Peter's School Marlow</b> is closing.
